Title: Understanding Child Abuse and Prevention

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Training Information

- **Type:** Locally developed
- **Delivery Method:** Online
- **Length:** One three-hour session
- **Availability:** Statewide
- **Language:** English
- **Age-level Focus:** Infant, Toddler, and Preschool
- **Cost:** \$30 per person

Training Description: Participants will learn how to identify the signs of abuse and neglect, describe how they impact child development, implement strategies to build resilience, and identify mandated responsibilities of reporting cases of child abuse and neglect.

Training Methods: Handouts, demonstration and practice during training, written reflection, hands-on activities, required reading, self or program assessment, peer discussion, interactive learning activities, and interactive learning games.
